Who is Jesus?

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." John 14:6

Q: What are your thoughts about Jesus?

Read Mark 4:35-41

Q: What are your initial thoughts or questions about this story?

Q: What do you think it would have been like to be one of the disciples in the boat?

Q: Have you ever had a frustrating moment with Jesus?

Q: What do we learn about Jesus from this passage?

There is a great quote by C.S. Lewis in Mere Christianity where he declares:

"I'm ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don't accept His claim to be God.' That is the one thing we must not say. A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher ... You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God: or else a madman or something worse. You can shut Him up for a fool ... or you can fall at His feet and call Him Lord and God. But let us not come with any patronizing nonsense about His being a great human teacher. He has not left that open to us." - Mere Christianity

Q: What are your thoughts on this quote?
